

8:30-10:00 Class: "Shadowbox Mounting: Can you Frame THIS?!", Patrice Marquardt, CPF

The wrinkled jersey is one thing, but what about the customer that wants two identical shadowboxes with only one set of objects? How about the acidic oak leaves in with the antique photo? The chewing tobacco with the hill-country Grandmothers bonnet? Or even just displaying a simple coin? This class discusses the dilemmas framers face in shadowbox framing and explores solutions to mounting the bulky, odd or irregular 3-D objects. Interactions of materials, the pull of gravity, acidity, and reversibility will be examined, with discussion of the techniques for protecting items safely for the long term. In this hands-on workshop, attendees will construct a take-home shop example.

Patrice started her career in 1977. She has earned the Certified Picture Framer designation, won competitions sponsored by PPFA, Crescent and Tru Vue, and is a PPFA approved judge. She started Marshall Framing Studio in Marshall, MI in 1992. The shop, now operated by Patrice and Tim Sykora, her husband and partner, has won several Top 100 Art & Framing Retailer. Patrice specializes in preservation, shadowboxes and restoration, and enjoys the daily challenges of running a small, successful independent shop.
